■ **Towing**

If a covered system fails, Value Guard will provide authorization or reimbursement for towing (limits apply).

■ **Alternate Transportation**

If your vehicle is repaired under Value Guard, you're covered for alternate transportation. Value Guard will pay the cost to rent a replacement vehicle or for public transportation (some limits apply) whenever two or more labor time guide hours are required for the repair, or your vehicle is not drivable and must be kept overnight.

Meets Your Needs

Choose the Value Guard term that is best for your situation. Coverage is offered based on years of anticipated ownership and annual mileage driven. Deductible choices are available from \$0 to \$200, meaning you can minimize unanticipated out-of-pocket expenses for covered repairs.

Value Guard can be purchased at any time during the new vehicle limited warranty period, but the earlier you buy, the better the value. If a vehicle is out-of-warranty when it is purchased, Value Guard can only be bought at the time of vehicle purchase. You can even make Value Guard part of your monthly payment.

Repair paperwork is gone too, because everything is taken care of by your GM dealer.

You may also enhance your vehicle's value because if you sell your vehicle, Value Guard can be transferred to the new owner for a small administrative fee.

With Value Guard, your vehicle is protected. Regardless of the term you select, Value Guard will give you peace of mind for the long run.

Q. **What is Value Guard?**

A. Value Guard is the quality vehicle service contract for cars, light-duty trucks and vans.

A. It covers the parts and labor costs of repairing specific components within nine major vehicle assemblies against failure – even if they result from wear and tear.* It also provides Towing and Alternate Transportation.

Q. **How much does Value Guard cost?**

A. That depends on the vehicle you're covering, the time, mileage, and deductible choices made, and when you purchase the contract.

Q. **Is Value Guard transferable?**

A. Yes. It can be transferred to the new owner upon sale of the vehicle, for a small administrative fee.

A. Value Guard has a money-back satisfaction guarantee. Cancel within 60 days (with no claims filed) for a full refund. After that, your refund is prorated (less an administrative fee).
